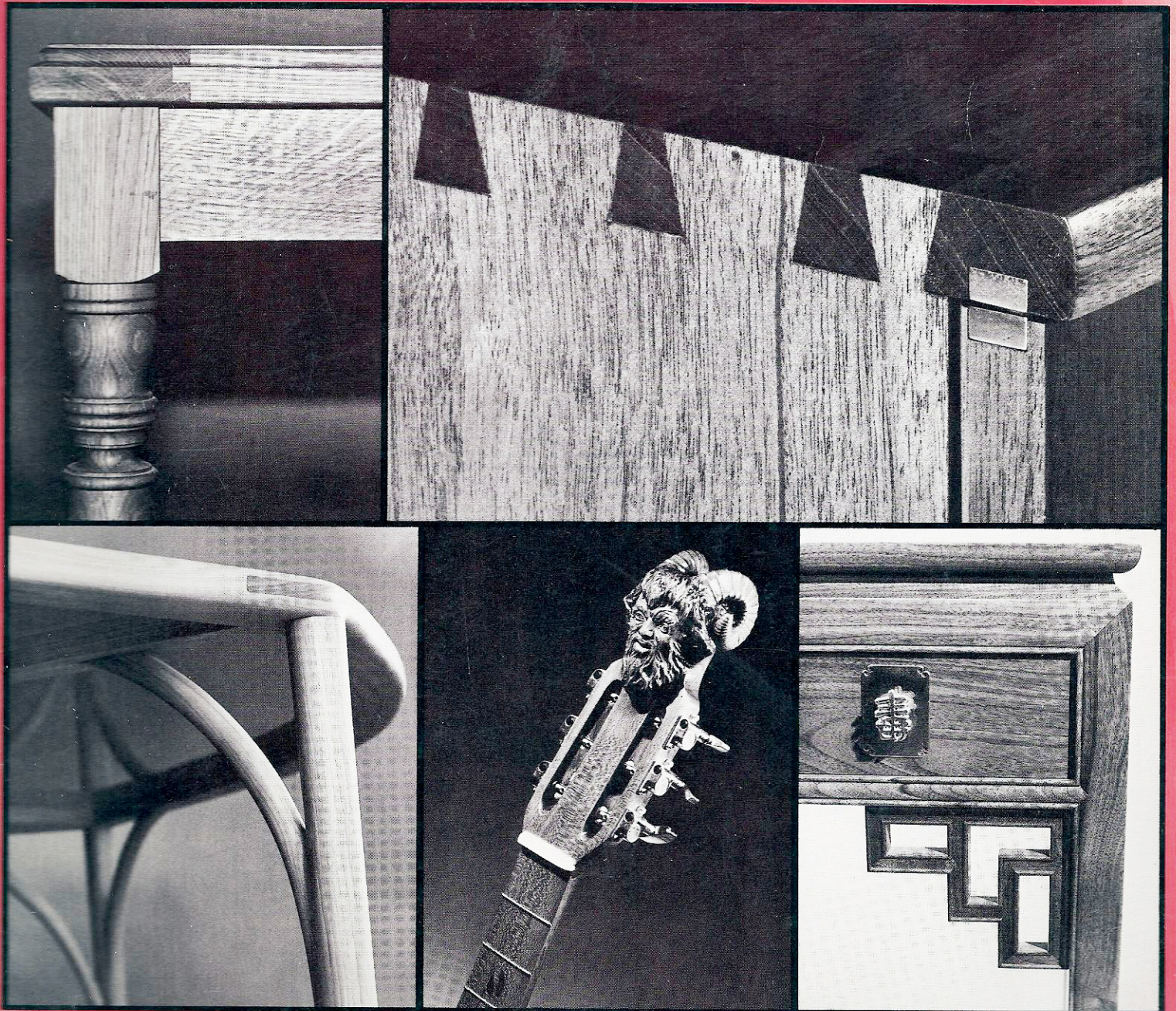

Weinerwald Bed; white oak, red oak, Honduras mahogany, basswood, walnut, 3/4-in. birch plywood; 86 x 72 x 54.

"Headboard and footboard cores are solid hardwood with 3-in. by 3-in. shaped oak frames joined to them. Mattress pedestal is red oak with a 3/4-in. birch plywood deck; it was built in two sections that bolt together to make the pedestal rigid. For access to bolts, as well as the carriage bolts that attach the headboard and footboard, removable 4-in. wide strips of 3/4-in. plywood are at the head and foot of each section. Each pedestal half has two storage drawers built into it."

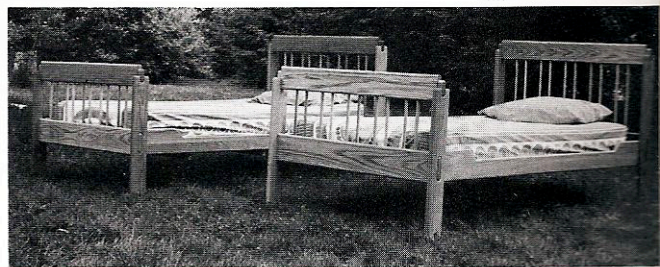
